Water Trust Board (WTB)

- Water Project Finance Act (the “Act”) created by 16-member WTB comprised of a diverse set of water users and experts
- The NMFA, on behalf of the WTB, annually accepts applications for water projects to be funded from Water Project Fund
- WTB recommends a list of projects to the Legislature to be authorized for funding from Water Project Fund
- The Act requires the WTB prioritize projects that:
 - Leverage local and federal funds;
 - Are shovel-ready;
 - Are identified as urgent to address public health and safety issues; and
 - Implement the State Water Plan



Parameters for WTB Funding

- Water Trust Board Policies require:
 - minimum contributions from all applicants in the form of local or federal matching funds
 - mandatory loan component of between 10% - 40% for all projects supported by rate-paying constituency
 - to the greatest extent possible, awards will be sized to projects that represent a functional project or stand-alone phase of a project that can be accomplished within 12-24 months of award
- Water Project fund annually receives 9% of senior Severance Tax Bonds (STB) and a distribution from Water Trust Fund and is subject to additional STB regulations; estimate for the 2026 cycle is \$162.1 million
- Applicants, applying for one or more projects in a given cycle, may not receive more than 15% of the available funds in any year. **15% of cap estimate \$24.3 million**

Preliminary Expenditures Target

- To be eligible for recommendation to the Legislature: By September 11, 2025 (Project Application due date), Applicants must demonstrate that all open WTB awards (those not yet certified as complete) from **2024 and prior** have been drawn down by the following amounts:
 - State-sponsored regional infrastructure projects must expend at least 35% of awards
 - Regional water association applicants must expend at least 60% of awards
 - All other applicants must expend at least 70% of awards
- Requisitions submitted by September 11th will count towards the drawn down requirement
- Waivers for consideration on the preliminary expenditure target **must be submitted within the project application**

The Basics:


- Through the NOI, the Applicant assigns a local administrator (“Super User/Primary Contact”) that is **authorized to submit** applications on behalf of the Applicant
- NMFA will assign *new Super Users and **Local Users a “User Name” and an initial “Password” (must be changed by the User)
 - *previous users may use their current passwords if there is no change in identified user
 - **local users must be members or employees of the Applicant
- Applicant must authorize NMFA (through the NOI) to attach any *consultants and/or engineers to the Applicant’s profile
 - Consultants and/or engineers cannot be “Super Users/Primary Contacts”

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

➤ Design only Projects

- If the WTB Funding Request is for design only, you may qualify for 100% grant with the following conditions:
 - The project serves or will serve fewer than 500 connections
 - The scope is limited to **design only** – “design” is defined as necessary technical work required to prepare a complete and final set of plans and specifications ready to be bid.
 - The costs for the design must be substantiated with the coordinating planning document(s)
 - Grants for design may not exceed \$500,000

➤ Project Funding

- WTB Budget Detail – Download form, complete, save to local drive and **upload** into application (note: you can add columns, but not rows)
- Non-WTB funding – Provide details of other funding. **Upload documentation** of secured match. If not documented, it will not count in the project evaluation
 - Resolution committing to match*;
 - Funding agreement – identifying amount and project description;
 - PER/Design costs – invoices, cancelled checks, etc.
 - Budget line items – must be identified

Please note, letter from official committing to match **is not a valid match document.*

In-kind labor and equipment is no longer eligible for match. (Implemented in 2023 cycle)

➤ Project Funding – Determining the Match

- Match is determined by: 1) WTB funding request, 2) Project Type and 3) Applicant's/Project area's MHI
- Tribal Applicants and **Projects** not supported by a rate paying constituency can provide an additional match in lieu of the required loan.
- *The Board may waive the match requirement for water systems when:
 - The Applicant serves fewer than 250 connections and has previously secured WTB funding for the proposed project as defined by planning document; or
 - System upgrade is to consolidate with another system; or
 - System upgrade/expansion is to incorporate previously unserved customers (not for future development); and
 - Applicant has implemented an asset management plan for the current and future maintenance, replacement and repair of the system

**Match waiver is determined at time of readiness application submission*

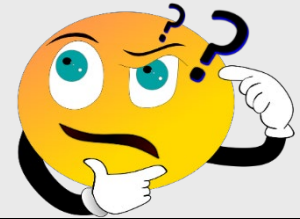



OSE determination continued:

◆ **Water Storage - DSB determination:**

- A permit from Dam Safety Bureau may be required if a jurisdictional dam (dam height equal to or greater than 25 ft and impoundment of 15 ac-ft or more; or height equal to or greater than 6 ft and impoundment of 50 ac-ft or more).

◆ **Flood Prevention:**

- **WRD determination:** A permit from water rights will be required if the dam does not drain within 96 hours
- **DSB determination:** A permit from Dam Safety Bureau may be required if a jurisdictional dam (dam height equal to or greater than 25 ft and impoundment of 15 ac-ft or more; or height equal to or greater than 6 ft and impoundment of 50 ac-ft or more)

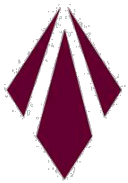

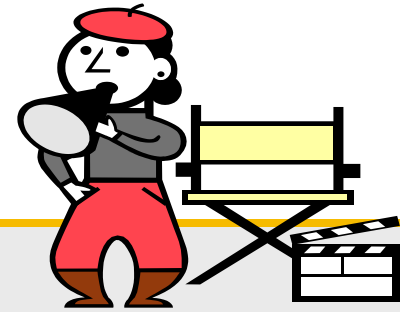
Project Recommendation to Legislature

- Projects are prioritized based upon the evaluations by PMT
- List is culled to the amount expected to be available for FY 2026
- Section 2.3 of the WTB Policies defines targeted annual funding percentages by project type:
 - Water Storage, Conveyance or Delivery 50% - 75%
 - Water Conservation or Recycling, Treatment or Reuse 15% - 30%
 - Wastewater Collection, Conveyance and Treatment 15% - 30%
 - Watershed Restoration and Management 10% - 20%
 - Flood Prevention Up to 10%
 - Endangered Species Act Implementation Up to 5%

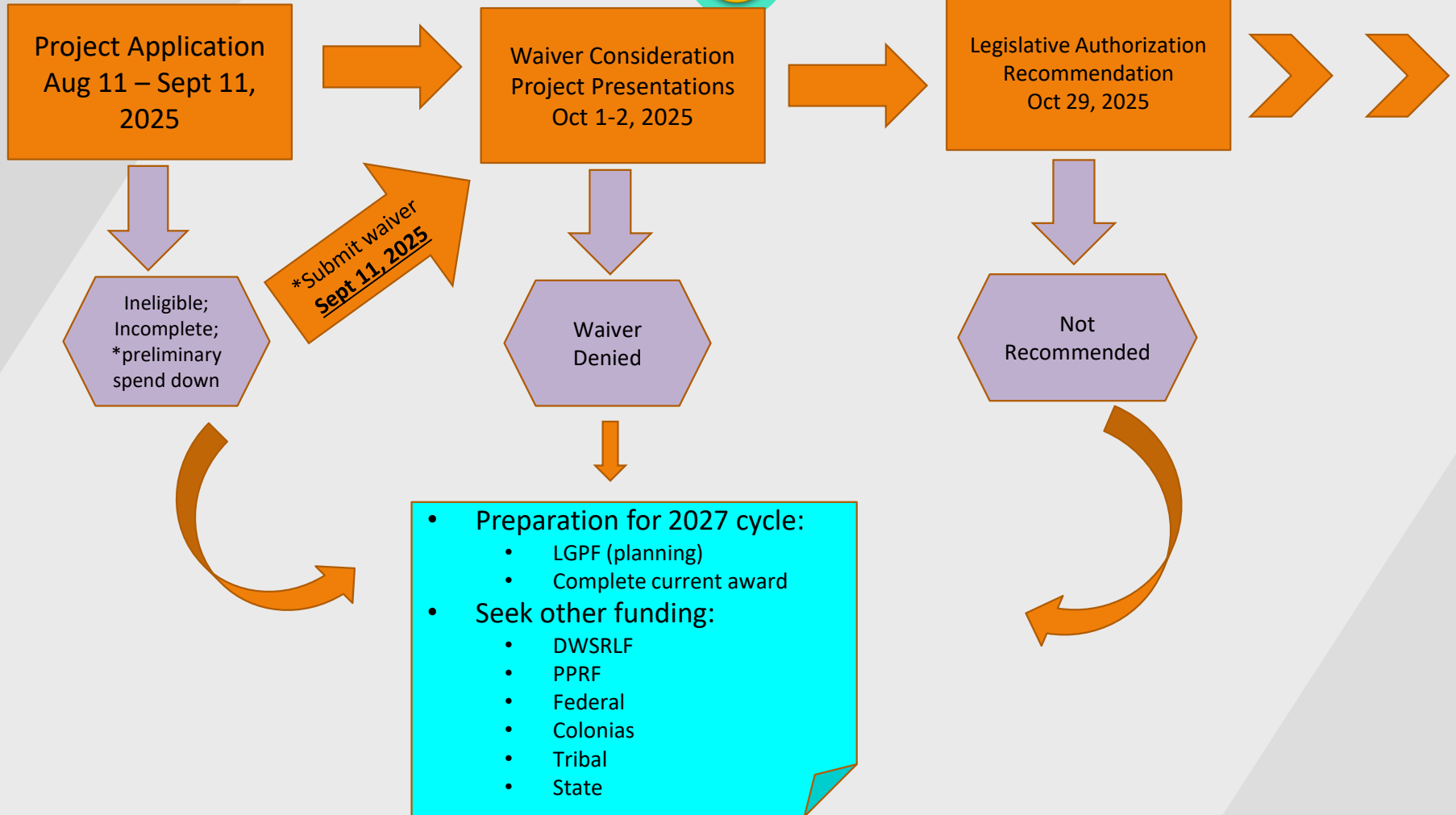

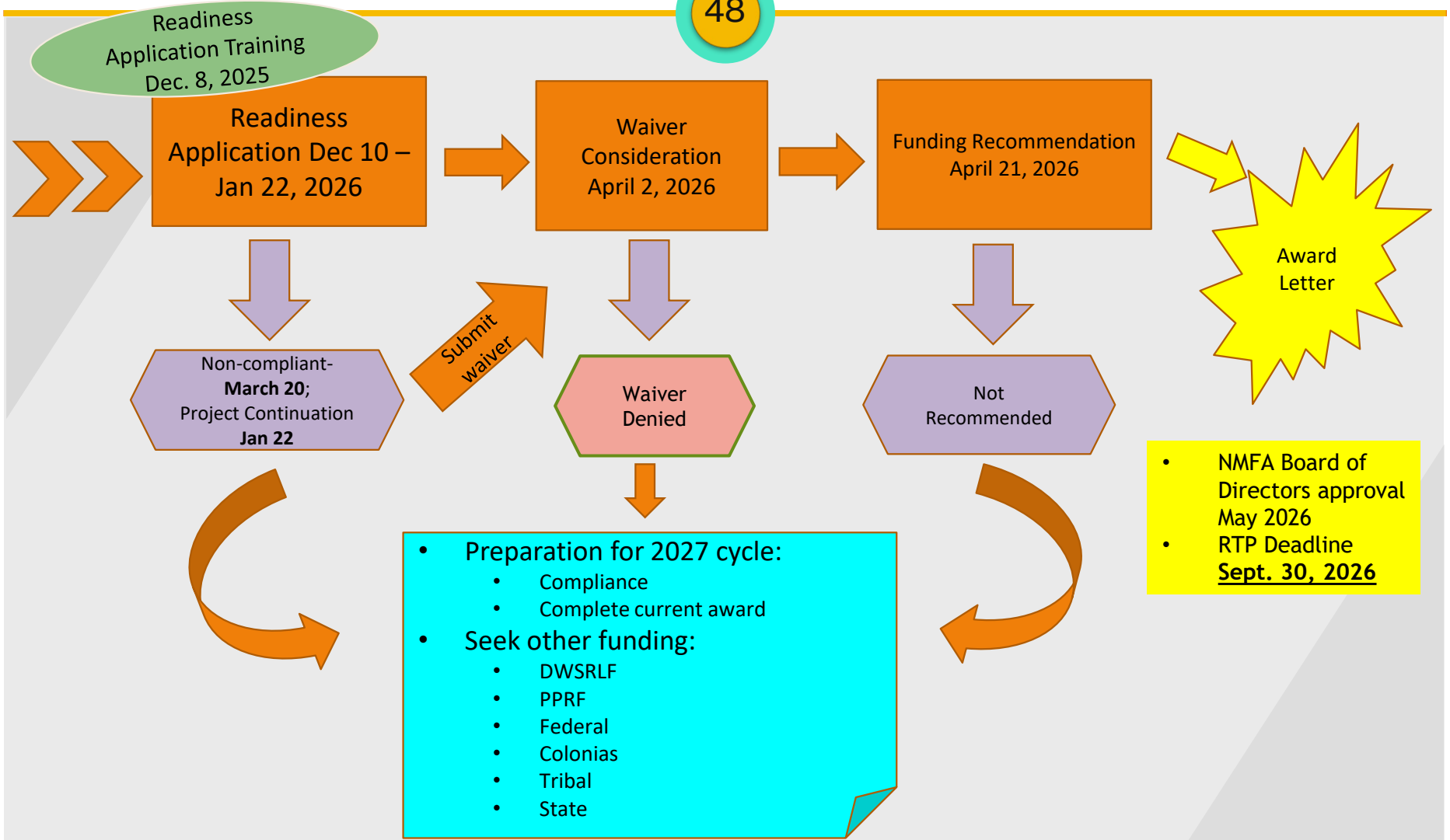

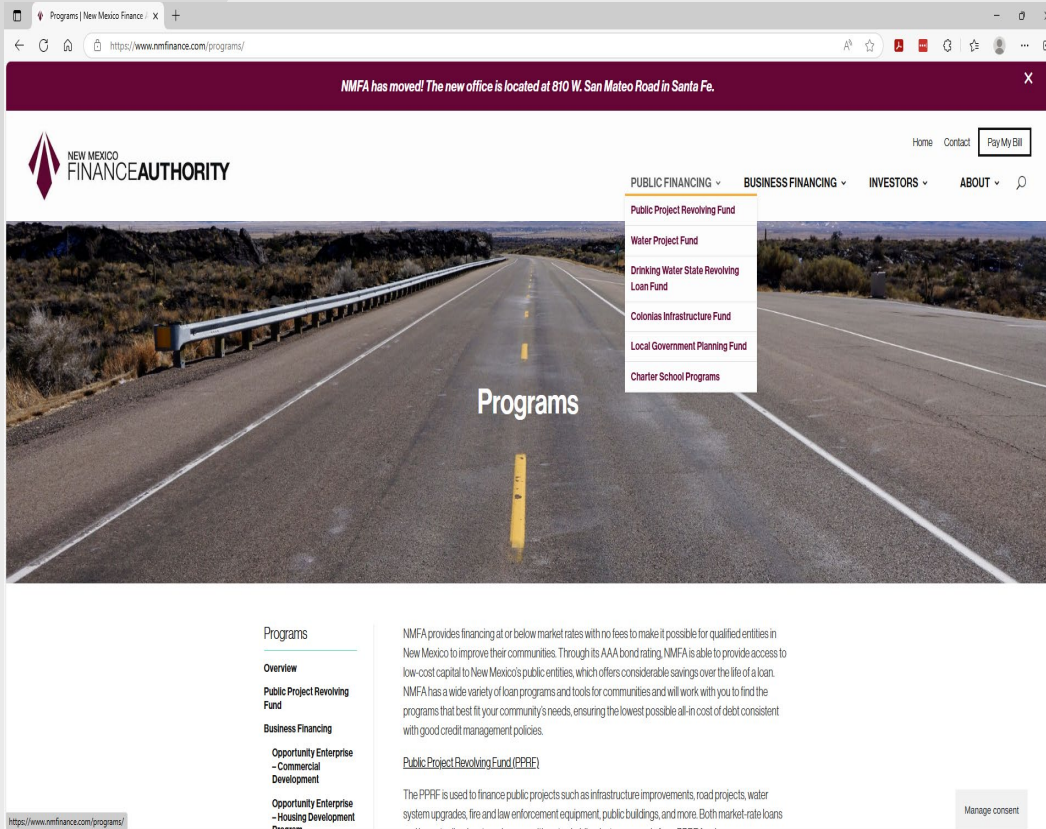
